Operation

- 1) You Travel up the funicular railway to the top of the reception slope & see the raft hanging up on a cable
- 2) Listen to a safety explanation and drunk a quick shot of Genepi, (optional)
- 3) Take your place in the raft - the guide joins you
- 4) Start your descent of You are ready to embark the reception slope of the Olympic Ski Jump, 90 metres long - 70 degrees angle – 5 second descent Approx.

Duration & Format

10 minute - introduction to the staff, briefing about the activity

10 minute - Funicular railway, panoramic view, ski jump visit

Approx. 5 second descent

5 minutes - handing in equipment

Restrictions

16+ - Under-18s must have written consent.
